TOPIC: Strategies and Safe Decision Making for Handling Incidents
Presented by: Laura Fiffick, Krause Bell Group

Summary - Organizational leaders play a critical role in the prevention of serious injuries and fatalities, yet many do not know where to start when it comes to strengthening their safety procedures. This presentation will provide understanding on how incidents occur and a model with which to understand and organize existing safety program components. Ms. Fiffick will explore data from over 60 serious and fatal incidents in order to understand the opportunities for safety professionals to contribute to safer decision-making in their organizations. She will propose some best practices for safe decision making, including strategies to recognize and reduce harmful bias.

Ms. Fiffick has over 25 years of experience in improving safety, health, and environmental (SHE) performance across organizations as an internal lead and external consultant. She has served as the lead for the National Safety Council's Campbell Institute, a non-profit organization collaborating with corporations across the globe seeking to create high-performing workplaces and workforces through leadership in SHE. She has also served on two ISO Standard Committees as part of the US Technical Advisory Groups (ISO 45001 Standard Committee – Occupational Health and Safety Management Systems and ISO 50001 – Energy Management Systems).

Ms. Fiffick holds a bachelor's degree in Geology from Texas A&M University and a master's degree from the University of Houston in Safety. She is a Certified Safety Professional and a Registered Environmental Manager.

Topic: Empowerment, Perception, and Leadership

Speaker: John McBride, SPHR, SHRM-SCP, Consentium Search

Summary - Two of the major factors that affect one’s ability to Lead are Empowerment and Perception. Empowerment is the actual power we wield in our roles as Safety Professionals. It is initially defined for the world, in this case our employment world, in our job descriptions and enhanced by our relationships with the people with whom we have the power to influence. The second factor is Perception, specifically the perception our colleagues have of us as Safety Professionals. Their perception is their reality. Do they see us the way we see ourselves? Do they perceive us as we want to be perceived? If not, either you need to change, their perception needs to change, or both.

Mr. McBride is the Director of National Recruiting with Consentium Search, a National Search and Recruiting Firm, specializing in sourcing Safety, Environmental and Workplace Health professionals. He is a ‘recovering HR professional’ having spent in excess of twenty years in roles such as Director of Human Resources and Director of Risk Management including oversight of the Safety functions for 1,000 internal and 55,000 outsourced, temporary employees.
