Food Safety for Outdoor Eating



Warm weather means grilling and picnicking. Keep these tips in mind this summer to prevent foodborne illness.

1. Clean Up - Pack soap, water and paper towels to clean hands and surfaces. Alcohol-based sanitizing lotion or wipes are an option too.
2. Watch the clock - Don't leave perishable food out of the cooler or off the grill for more than two hours - one hour on days over 90°F.
3. Be sure to bring enough serving utensils - You'll help avoid spreading germs if each dish has its own spoon or tongs.
