Voting concluded on October 4, 2014, regarding the motion to the HoD to approve SOG 6.35 - Rules for Campaigning after Nomination for Society Office. <http://www.asse.org/about/sog-section-635/> The motion passed by a vote of 121 in favor and 16 against, with 58% of delegates voting.
