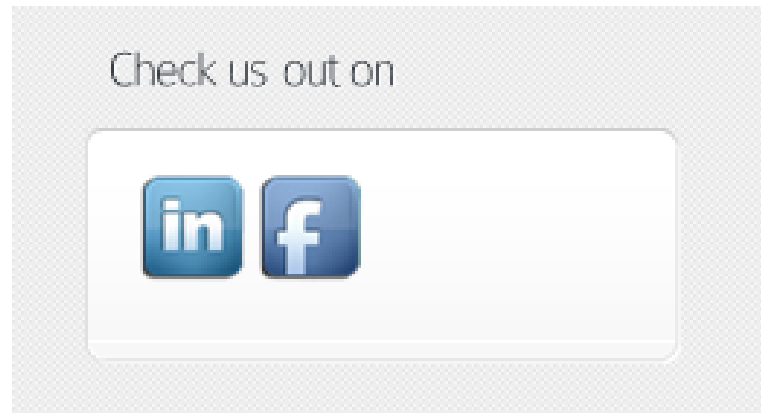

Subcommittee	Members	Materials Needed/ Notes
Advertising		Develops advertising for local and national publications; uses social media to promote the conference; finalizes 2016 logo
Catering and Meals		Chooses the breakfast, snack and lunch menus; works with registration coordinator to match meal requests with registrants; provides menu options to web-master and registration coordinator for inclusion with registration web pages; meet with venue staff and Co-Chairs
Conference Venue	John DiPaolo	Coordinates venue setup: tables, stages, tech equipment; meets with venue staff
Corporate Sponsors and Exhibitors		Solicits sponsors and exhibitors; assists with registration; coordinates space needs with conference venue coordinator; provides sponsor and exhibitor information to conference materials; coordinator for banners, posters, etc. to highlight Sponsors.
Registration and Conference Materials (programs, posters, etc.)		Works with web master to develop or refine registration forms; tracks registration progress; updates registration forms when 'early bird' registration is over; provides registration reports to committee as needed; coordinates on-site registration activities; finalizes conference programs materials; arranges for printing of materials and posters; coordinates assembly of packets for the conference.
Room Monitors, audio/visual needs, and e-surveys		Identifies projectors and laptops needed that can be borrowed . Assures AV materials are functioning each day; uploads presentations; introduces speakers; monitors room conditions. Also, assures survey kiosks (with laptops) function to take participant comments/evaluations
Presenters		Contacts speakers to assure they register, submit abstracts for vetting, and materials on time; coordinates special speaker needs.
Presenter Gifts		Chooses unique gifts for speakers (~\$?? /gift) and door prizes
Treasurer		Collects all invoices and receipts to be paid; appraises SPC Chair and Executive Board of SPC financial status; finalizes all costs/revenue for submission to Chair and Executive board
Web-Master	Dave Jeary	Coordinates with Advertising and registration to maintain constant digital presence to memberships of ASSE and partnering SPC organizations
